1	<b>新加坡 北京 - 天安门广场 - 紫禁城 - 杂技表演</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>乘豪华客机飞往中国首都 - 北京。</li> <li>参观世界最大的城中广场 - 天安门广场。位于北京市中心，南北长 880 米，东西宽 500 米，面积达 44 万平方米，可容纳 100 万人举行盛大集会。天安门城楼坐落在广场的北端，五星红旗在广场上空高高飘扬；人民英雄纪念碑屹立在广场的中央；人民大会堂和中国国家博物馆在广场的东西两侧遥遥相对；毛主席纪念堂和正阳门城楼矗立在广场的南部。过后前往故宫，也称紫禁城，是明清两朝的皇宫禁苑。它位于北京市中心，东西宽 753 米，南北长 961 米，面积达 72 万平方米，是世界上规模最大的宫殿建筑群。</li> <li>用完晚餐后，前往欣赏中国著名的传统节目 - 杂技表演。</li> </ul>	午餐 晚餐
2	<b>北京 - 长城 - 明皇蜡像馆 - 颐和园 - 外观奥运场馆鸟巢 + 水立方</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>早餐后，您将从居庸关长城向上攀登，体会不登长城非好汉的感觉。万里长城横贯中国北方大地，全长 6000 多公里，是中国古代最大的御古建筑之一。</li> <li>午餐后，参观明皇蜡像馆，是目前世界上最大的蜡像艺术宫。这座“巍峨壮美、气韵浮动”的白色大殿，从翘起的飞檐和挺拔的楼体看出建筑者在现代与古典相结合建筑构思上下的功夫。被誉为“东方的卢浮宫”。</li> <li>颐和园为中国四大名园之首，也是慈禧太后晚年的颐养之地。这里集绚丽多姿的中国皇家园林与建筑艺术之大成，是明清皇家避暑胜地及行宫。</li> <li>续程往 2008 年奥运主场馆“鸟巢”及水上竞技项目的“水立方”，观赏其独特的建筑外观。</li> </ul>	早餐 午餐 晚餐
3	<b>北京 - 天坛 - 正阳门城楼 - 前门明清一条街 - 首都博物馆</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>早餐后，游览中国现代最大坛庙建筑之天坛，它乃明、清两代帝王祀天祈谷的坛庙。天坛占地 273 公顷，建筑布局呈“回”字形，由两道坛墙分成内坛、外坛两大部分。外坛墙总长 6416 米，内坛墙总长 3292 米。最南的围墙呈方型，象征地，最北的围墙呈半圆型，象征天，北高南低，这既表示天高地低，又表示“天圆地方”。</li> <li>参观正阳门城楼。因其位于紫禁城的正前方，又有“前门”之称。正阳门是老北京“京师九门”之一。它集正阳门城楼、正阳门箭楼与正阳门瓮城为一体，是一座完整的古代防御性建筑体系。据地方志上记载：当时的城楼、箭楼规模宏丽，形制高大；瓮城气势雄浑，为老北京城垣建筑的代表作。五百年来，正阳门饱经沧桑，几毁几修，现仅存城楼和箭楼，是目前北京城内唯一保存较完整的城门。城楼上有北京民俗展览馆。</li> <li>前门明清一条街，是北京最著名商业街，是老北京市井风貌、史迹文物保存最完整的地区之一，特别是明清以来，一直是北京建筑文化、商贾文化、市井文化、会馆文化、民俗文化、梨园文化最为发达的特色街区。明朝永乐皇帝定都北京后，以一条规整的南北向中轴线来营建其都城，内城设置城门九座，南城居中正阳门，老百姓将其俗称前门。</li> <li>首都博物馆于 1953 年开始筹备，中途几经周折，1981 年正式对外开放，馆址设在孔庙内。“北京历史文物陈列”是首都博物馆的基本陈列。时限上溯数十万年前，下迄 1949 年。通过一系列的图表、模型、文物，多层次、多侧面地展示了北京历史发展的风貌。</li> </ul>	早餐 午餐 晚餐
4	<b>北京 - 国家大剧院 - 三轮车胡同游 - 雅秀市场 - 什刹海酒吧一条街</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>早餐后，参观中国国家大剧院位于北京天安门广场西。由国家大剧院主体建筑及南北两侧的水下长廊、地下停车场、人工湖、绿地组成总建筑面积约 16.5 万平方米，国家大剧院建筑屋面呈半椭圆形，整个建筑漂浮于人造水面之上，行人需从一条 80 米长的水下通道进入演出大厅。国家大剧院庞大的椭圆外形在长安街上显得像个“天外来客”，与周遭环境的冲突让它显得十分抢眼。这座“城市中的剧院、剧院中的城市”以一颗献给新世纪的超越想象的“湖中明珠”的奇异姿态出现。</li> <li>乘坐老北京人力三轮车游览老北京古老的民宅和街道一胡同，来更深层体会老北京的文化。</li> <li>后赴雅秀市场及什刹海酒吧街。</li> </ul>	早餐 午餐 晚餐

1	<b>Singapore  Beijing – Tiananmen – Forbidden City – Acrobatic Show</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Assemble at Changi International Airport for your flight to Beijing.</li> <li>Upon arrival, visit the famous place – <b>Tiananmen Square</b>. Tiananmen Square is at the heart of Beijing, the largest urban square in the world. The Square measures 880 metres from north to south, 500 metres from east to west and can accommodate up to one million people.</li> <li>Visit the <b>Forbidden City</b>. The Forbidden City (<i>Zijincheng</i>) (also known as the Imperial Palace (<i>Gugong</i>) and the Palace Museum) is the largest and best preserved collection of ancient buildings in China. The complex is divided into two sections: the Inner Court or the living quarters, and the working area also known as the Outer Court. After dinner, proceed to enjoy the <b>China Acrobatic Show</b>.</li> </ul>	Lunch Dinner
2	<b>Beijing – Juyongguan Great Wall – Wax Museum – Summer Palace – View the external Facade of Beijing National Stadium “Bird’s Nest + “Water Cube”</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In the morning, head towards Juyongguan Great Wall. It was a massive defence project that represented the wisdom and tenacity of the ancient Chinese, and till today it has been a symbolic achievement of the Chinese people.</li> <li>After lunch, visit the Wax Museum. It is situated at the west of Changping Xiguan rotary island, and is in the present world, the biggest wax figure palace of art. It is honoured as “East’s Louvre”.</li> <li>After lunch, proceed to Summer Palace. This palace is originally called ‘Qingyi Garden’, like most of the gardens in Beijing, it could not elude the rampages of the Anglo-French allied force and was destroyed by fire. In 1886, <b>Empress Dowager Cixi</b> embezzled navy funds to reconstruct it for her own benefit, changing its name to Summer Palace (Yihe Yuan). She spent most of her later years there, dealing with state affairs and entertainment.</li> <li>On the way, you will be able to view the 2008 Olympic Stadium, Bird’s Nest &amp; Water Cube’s outward appearance.</li> </ul>	Breakfast Lunch Dinner
3	<b>Beijing – Temple Of Heaven Park – Zhengyang Gate – Qianmen Mingqing Street – Capital Museum</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>After breakfast, visit <b>Temple of Heaven Park</b> , which was built in the 15<sup>th</sup> century and restored in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. The temple is 37.4 metres high, and was constructed entirely out of wood without the use of any nails, making it one of the architectural wonders of the world. The Temple buildings and the parklands reflect ancient Chinese religious beliefs that pictures heaven as a round shape, and earth as a square shape. Thus, the buildings in the temple are constructed on a central axis. The temples themselves are round and the bases are square.</li> <li>After that, visit <b>Zhengyang Gate</b>. In 1965, it was named Qianmen Street officially. However, Beijing did not keep the architecture of Mingguo Period. The Qianmen Street was rebuilt into a walking street by the Beijing government. The Dangdang vehicle measuring 10 metres and weighing 20 tonnes then moved back. It was designed according to the French Dangdang vehicle, but was made in Beijing factory.</li> <li>The new <b>Capital Museum</b>, with its magnificent architecture, abundant exhibitions, advanced technology and complete functions, makes its contribution to titles such as “famous historical and cultural city”, “cultural centre” and “international metropolis” of Beijing, and ranks among the first class museums in China as well as the World.</li> </ul>	Breakfast Lunch Dinner
4	<b>Beijing – National Grand Theatre – Trishaw Tour of Hutong – Yaxiu Clothing Market – Shenshai Bar &amp; Pub Street</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Today, we will visit the <b>National Grand Theatre</b>, which is a dynamic new icon to the arts, in the heart of old Beijing. The theatre’s ultra-modern architecture is in sharp contrast to its neighbours, the Great Hall of the People, Tiananmen Square and the ancient Forbidden City. The main building, which has no doors, angles or beams, is surrounded by a small lake that compliments the tranquil nature of the structure, which changes its hue depending on how the sun shines. Visitors enter the grand hall via a stunning 80-metre-long corridor. The theatre’s surrounding landscape, which are its gardens and trees, its lake and pedestrian-only paths are an invitation to a leisurely stroll around the arts facility.</li> <li>It is time for you to experience another type of transportation, which is the <b>trishaw ride</b>, where you can be pulled along by the trishaw rider through the old Beijing street or called “Hutong”, where you can feel the traditional culture in Beijing.</li> <li>After head to <b>Yaxiu Clothing Market</b> to shop for the latest fashion and accessories at great bargains</li> <li>Visit the <b>Shenshai bar and pub street</b>.</li> </ul>	Breakfast Lunch Dinner
