DAY 1 : SINGAPORE / OSAKA (via Tokyo)
(Breakfast on board) NH902 SIN/NRT 2325/0725*1
Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport Terminal 2, for your pleasant flight to **Osaka** (via Tokyo).

DAY 2 : OSAKA / KYOTO CITY TOUR
(Lunch / Dinner) NH21 HND/ITM 1100/1205
Upon arrival, proceed to **Osaka Castle** (admission to Castle's Museum not included). Visit the famous **Kinkakuji** (Golden Pavilion) originally built in 1394. Next, the **Kiyomizu Temple** (World Heritage), famous for its huge veranda jutting out over an exquisite valley that extends to a panoramic view of the city.

Accommodation:
Gifu Miyako Hotel or similar.

DAY 3 : GIFU / SHIRAGAWAGO / TAKAYAMA (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast, proceed to **Toki Premium Outlets**, featured in a structure inspired by the beautiful small towns of Colorado, USA. Visit **Shirakawago** (World Heritage), traditional old farmhouses with steeply pitched thatched roofs architecture "Gassho" style. Next, visit the old streets of **Takayama/Sanmachi**, almost unchanged since the Edo Period.

Accommodation:
Takayama Washington Hotel or similar.

DAY 4 : TATEYAMA-KUROBE ALPINE ROUTE (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
This morning, we'll travel the **Tateyama-Kurobe Alpine Route***, a magnificent mountain-sightseeing route winding its way from the convenience of a cable car, bus, ropeway and trolley bus. Be overwhelmed by its scale, Japan's No. 1 and biggest dam – **Kurobe Dam**.

*Tateyama-Kurobe Alpine Route operates from mid April till end November.
Accommodation:
Matsumoto Tokyu Inn or similar.

DAY 5 : MATSUMOTO / LAKE KAWAGUCHI (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast visit **Matsumoto Castle** (admission to Castle's Museum not included), registered as a national treasure. Next is **Zenkoji Temple** (designated a national treasure), the temple is famous for its way of worshipping where people walk blindly through a completely dark underground corridor to touch the "Lord of Paradise". Thereafter, have fun picking fresh fruits of season at **Isawa** (subject to seasonality). This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.

Accommodation:
Lake Kawaguchi Park Hotel or similar.

DAY 6 : LAKE SAIKO / TOKYO
(Breakfast / Dinner)
After breakfast, proceed to **Lake Saiko** which is rich in nature. It has a healing town contains the replica of a settlement with rafted roofs which offers a chance to experience and buy traditional craftwork such as paper-making and ceramic. Next **Gotemba Premium Outlets**, shop for brand name where you're bound to find something you like. Thereafter, ample time will be given at **Ginza** and **Shinjuku** district.

Tokyo Sunshine Prince Hotel or similar.

DAY 7 : TOKYO / SINGAPORE (Breakfast)
