DAY 1 : SINGAPORE / HOKKAIDO
(via Tokyo) (Breakfast on board)
NH902 SIN/NRT 2325/0725*1
Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport Terminal 2, for your pleasant flight to Hokkaido (via Tokyo).

DAY 2 : CHITOSE / SHIRAOI AINU VILLAGE / NOBORIBETSU HOT SPRING RESORT
(Lunch / Dinner) NH61 HND/CTS 1100/1235
Upon arrival at Chitose Airport, proceed for lunch thereafter visit Rera Chitose Outlet Mall. Next, Shiraoi Ainu Village to get a better picture of the Ainu lifestyle through the display of their precious heirlooms, traditional embroidery, song and dance. This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.
Accommodation:
Noboribetsu Manseikaku Hotel or similar.

DAY 3 : NOBORIBETSU / OTARU / SAPPORO (Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast, visit Jigokudani (Hell Valley), where columns of steam incessantly rise from the numerous fissures in the rocks. Next, travel to the romantic town of Otaru, a lively port city famous for its canal and glasswork shops. Take a photo stop at the Otaru Canal where all the century-old stone warehouses are lined both sides of the canal. Visit Kitaichi Glass Museum, a store of exquisite glass art followed by the Otaru Music Box Museum, where you can enjoy looking at all the beautifully crafted music boxes and listen to its heavenly music. En-route to Sapporo, visit the Odori Park, where the Sapporo TV Tower is located and have a great shopping spree at the Underground Shopping Mall.
Accommodation:
Sapporo Apa & Resort Hotel or similar.

DAY 4 : SAPPORO / SOU-BETSU / MT. SHOWA / LAKE TOYA
(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast drive pass the historic Clock Tower. After which stop by Fruit Farm for a memorable fruit-picking experience (subject to seasonality). Then proceed to visit the Ezo grizzly bears and their cubs at the Bear Ranch located at the foot of Mt. Showa, an active volcano. Next, a photo stop at Lake Toya then check into an "onsen" hotel, where you'll get a chance to view fireworks* by the lake in the evening. You can also relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.
*Fireworks are organised by the local authority and is subject to change or cancel without prior notice.
Accommodation:
Lake Toya Kanko Hotel or similar.

DAY 5 : LAKE TOYA / HAKODATE
(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast, we'll journey down to Hakodate, where you can stroll through the historic streets lined with Western-styled houses which abound in Hakodate. Have a photo-stop at Goryokaku, Japan's first Western-style fortification. Next, Waterfront Warehouses where old brick warehouses have been renovated to serve as beer halls, restaurants and souvenir shops. This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.
Accommodation:
Hakodate Shikabe Royal Hotel or similar.

DAY 6 : HAKODATE / TOKYO
(Breakfast / Dinner) NH854 HKD/HND 1240/1405
After breakfast visit Hakodate Morning Market where you can get the freshest sashimi or dried seafood, vegetables, fruits, etc at wholesale prices. Then transfer to Hakodate Airport for your flight to Tokyo. Upon arrival, proceed for a city tour and we shall drive pass the Imperial Palace and Tokyo Tower. Next, visit the famous Asakusa Kannon Temple. At the Nakamise Shopping Street, where colourful street filled with wide selection of souvenirs and traditional Japanese snacks. Next The Daiso, every item is priced at 100 yen, with some exceptions. Thereafter proceed to Ueno, where you can purchase everything from food products, upscale fashions and other miscellaneous goods at reasonable prices.

Tokyo Sunshine Prince Hotel or similar.

DAY 7 : TOKYO / SINGAPORE (Breakfast)
