DAY 1 : SINGAPORE / TOKYO

(Meals on board) NH902 SIN/NRT 2325/0725*1
Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport Terminal 2 for your pleasant flight to Tokyo.

DAY 2 : TOKYO / TOCHIGI – Nikko City

(Lunch / Dinner)
Upon arrival, visit the famous Asakusa Kannon Temple. At the Nakamise Shopping Street, where colourful street filled with wide selection of souvenirs and traditional Japanese snacks. Next The Daiso, every item is priced at 100 yen, with some exceptions. After lunch journey to Nikko, Lake Chuzenji, a beautiful lake with forested shores. This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.

Accommodation:

Kinugawa Green Palace Hotel or similar.

DAY 3 : TOCHIGI / FUKUSHIMA – Kitakata City / Aizuwakamatsu

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
This morning visit Nikko Toshogu (World Heritage), home to one of the must-see Japanese architecture, famous for its lavish ornamental carving. Then proceed to visit Tsuruga Castle (admission to Castle's Museum not included), one of the best known historic castles in Tohoku. We'll also visit the Aizu Samurai Residence, a mansion of the chief retainer of Aizu clan. Next explore the making and sample sake in Aizu Sake History Museum. Next we'll take the "Travelator" up to Mt. Iimori, home to a memorial of the "Byakkotai" or White Tigers - a group of samurai youths who committed heroic suicide here in 1868. Have a fruitful session as you experience fruit picking at Fruit Farm (subject to seasonality). This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.

Accommodation:

Fukushima Listel Inawashiro Hotel or similar.

DAY 4 : FUKUSHIMA / MIYAKI – Matsushima / City of Sendai

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
This morning proceed to Goshikinuma, a five color ponds changes depending on weather conditions. Along the way to Matsushima Bay, we will visit renowned Hanamiyama Park*. Next, visit the Zuiganji Temple, Tohoku's most famous Zen temple which is well known for its beautifully painted sliding doors. Followed by the Godaido Hall, that perched on a small island in Matsushima bay. Partake in the traditional Japanese tea ceremony at Kanrantei. Next take a stroll at Nishi Park* in Sendai city, popular for its beautiful cherry blossoms and autumn colors. Thereafter shopping at Ichibancho Arcade Street.

*Seasonal inclusion during cherry blossom season.

Accommodation:

Sendai Best Western Hotel or similar.

DAY 5 : IWATE – Hiraizumi

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)
After breakfast, proceed to visit Chusonji Temple, featuring layers of valuable black-lacquer and gold leaf. Have Wanko soba lunch at Hatsukoma Inter Branch (eat-all-you-can). Followed by Genbikei Gorge, spectacular in all four seasons and also famous for its "Flying Dango" – sweet sticky riceball. Visit to Morioka Handi Works Square that introduces Iwate's traditional handicraft arts and local specialties. This evening, relax yourself in one of the onsen (hot spring bath) within the hotel.

Accommodation:

Akita Hotel Tazawa or similar.

DAY 6 : AKITA – Lake Tazawa / TOKYO

(Breakfast / Dinner)

Make a photo stop at Lake Tazawa, the deepest lake in Japan and visit to Kakunodate Samurai Residence, a historic town dotted with samurai residences and storehouses. After lunch, transfer to Akita Airport to catch a flight back to Tokyo. Free to shop at Aqua City Odaiba, Decks Tokyo Beach.

Accommodation:

Narita Garden Hotel or similar. Hotel is not located in Tokyo city. It is near Narita International Airport.
